

UH-60 IPC COURSE

1. Enclosed is the information you will need prior to attending the UH-60 IPC Course at Western ARNG Aviation Training Site, Silverbell Army Heliport, Marana, Arizona.

2. REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. **AIR:** WAATS does not provide transportation for students to and from airports. The cost for a Taxi to and from Tucson airport is approximately \$135 cash that must be paid by the student upon arrival and departure. This expense is reimbursable on your travel voucher.
- b. **ARRIVAL:** Students are required to arrive at the Western AATS no earlier than 24 hours prior to start date, unless you clear it with the WAATS Brigade S-3 in advance. Your dormitory key will be issued at the installation gate by security personnel 24/7. Entry onto the installation requires a current military ID card. Pets or personally owned weapons are not allowed on the installation.
- c. **DEPARTURE:** Students will not schedule a departure prior to 1430 hrs on the final day of the course. Exceptions will be made only with approval from the TASS BN Commander. If requested in advance, you are authorized one night stay after graduation if traveling by POV.

3. IN-PROCESSING:

- a. ATRRS report date is your “travel day” and your ATRRS start date is your in-processing day.
- b. **MEDICAL:** In-processing will begin at 0700 hrs at the WAATS Troop Medical Clinic located in building L4500. Students are to check for the latest information on channel 3 on your room TV prior to reporting to the TMC. Duty uniform will be the Army Physical Fitness Uniform (No exceptions).
- c. **ADMINISTRATIVE:** The WAATS in-processing briefs will be held upstairs at 0800hrs in classroom 262/263.

4. ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Students must meet height/weight or body fat standards as stated in AR 600-9.
- b. Students with a permanent profile are required to bring a copy of DA Form 3349.
- c. No temporary profiles are allowed.
- d. 3 copies of your orders.
- e. Class Specific Requirements:
 - IATF/IFRF Flight Record Folders
 - CAFRS PCS file with close out from home unit
 - NGB Aviation Service Orders
 - Current instrument evaluation
 - NVG current and qualified
 - Current DA 4186 from home unit
 - Proof of currency UH-60

- UH-60 qualification orders, i.e. DA Form 1059 or DA 87 Graduation Certificate
- Current STAN EVAL
- 500 hrs rotary wing
- Current UH-60 PC
- 50 hrs as PC
- 250 flight hours in UH-60
- Letter of recommendation from CDR
- If you do not meet flight hour requirements, fill out the enclosed waiver request form to and send to usarmy.az.azarnq.list.waats-brigade-s-3-section@mail.mil or fax to 520-750-5502.

 Individual flight gear (vest, flight helmet, etc.) 1 ea
 A2ACU, or flight suit 2 ea
 Undershirts 6 ea
 Boots, combat (aviation) 2 pr IAW AR 670-1
 Patrol cap 1ea
 Boonie hat 1 ea
 Identification tags/card 1pr/1ea (tags and DD Form 2)
 High visibility reflective belt (running belt) for personal physical fitness training 1 ea
